This helps them know what color vestments to put & if they need to change the curtains behind the altar. It also helps them know if it is a special feast day & what the readings of the day should be. They mark the readings in the Roman Missal & prepare all the vessels for Holy Communion. They work together to make sure everything is ready for Fr. Rudy, the Deacons & our school community in time for our school liturgies each week.
