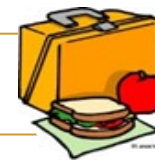

Laying a Strong Foundation: September - Building on FAITH

“When Jesus entered the house, the blind men approached him and He said to them, ‘Do you believe that I can do this?’ ‘Yes, Lord.’ Then He touched their eyes and said, ‘Let it be done for you according to your faith.’” (Matthew 9: 28-29)

We often think of FAITH as an act of our will: “I choose to believe.” But really we cannot have access to God by our own choice! We can know God only because God chooses to reveal Himself to us. In God’s goodness, God lets us know Him through the gift of FAITH.

We can deepen our faith through study and prayer—if we want to deepen our relationship with a person, we seek to learn more about that person and to spend time with that them. It is the same with our God.

This month can we choose to spend a bit more time with our God? (Think about this for a moment!) How will I strengthen my relationship with God through prayer? Is there a way that my family could pray more this month and we could ask God to increase our faith?

Good works follow on FAITH and prove the realness of faith. True faith challenges us to share and to proclaim the love and truth we have found in Jesus Christ so that His good news becomes known to those around us.

Let us pray for each other this month that we truly can grow in the virtue and grace of FAITH!
