This week in the STREAM lab some of the 5th graders began the building of their MagLev train. Just like last week's group, this group is having to check polarity of the magnetic poles so as to get repulsion of their trains. We will keep you posted with pictures.

They began their project with gliders that had set instructions to build and they had to add some innovation to their gliders.
