Teachers we will be meeting with parents to discuss what we teach and how we teach.

The schedule of meetings are as follows:

- Nov. 5: PK3 - Kinder
- Nov. 6: 1st - 3rd grade
- Nov. 7: 4th & 5th grade
- Nov. 12: 6th - 8th grade

We are planning for one-hour meetings starting at 6:30 p.m.. Parents will meet in the cafeteria for the first 20 - 25 minutes and the following information will be presented following specific to grade levels:

- ◇ What is Curriculum? What is a Standards-based curriculum? A look at the TEK's
- ◇ What can be realistically taught? Pacing Guides / Essential Learning
- ◇ Focusing on learning objectives critical to current and next grade level
- ◇ 21st Century Skills & Developing Character / Etiquette
- ◇ Promoting rigor in the classroom
- ◇ Parental Best Practice / Tips for raising well-adjusted children
- ◇ How do we assess student learning from year to year?
- ◇ What makes a child do well in school?

After the cafeteria presentation, parents are welcome to join their child's teacher in their child's appropriate classroom until the conclusion of the hour.

Teachers are encouraged to review the following information:

- ⇒ Major learning objectives of the 1st quarter and to preview major learning objectives of the 2nd quarter.
- ⇒ Specific types of learning strategies and activities they are currently using.
- ⇒ Give examples of how students are assessed in elementary grade level in their different subject areas.
- ⇒ Student involvement in future events for Thanksgiving and Christmas.
- ⇒ Information on Catholic Social Teachings which are being addressed monthly
