

### \*\*2nd Semester Reminders\*\*

Please review the following reminders to help us ease into the 2nd half of our GREAT school year. Please discuss these reminders with your children, and any family members who are active participants in our Charger Family.

- Early Morning Drop Off (before 7:44am) must be at the front of the cafeteria on Beryl Dr. where Fr. Rudy and Seminarian Paul serve as crossing guards. Students wanting to visit the Library will be picked up from the "Library" table in the cafeteria at 7:30.
- Students under the age of 8 or under 4'9" must have a child safety seat in vehicles that pick them up in our car line.
- Girls' skirts must be no shorter than 3 in. from the middle of the knee (front or back). Girls' were given warnings re: skirt length before the Christmas break. Girls who did not have their skirt hems lengthened will earn signatures.
- Boys who have shaven, must continue to be clean shaven. Warnings were given before break. Boys who break this school rule will earn signatures.
- Lunch visitors will be limited to once per week. In the best interest of our students and their social skills, family members should not visit their student for lunch more than once a week. When a family member joins a student for lunch, the student may NOT be on an electronic device. We are working on our Charger Etiquette and Social Skill involving conversation.
- Family members may only bring lunch for their student, (not other students).
