## LEARNING PLATFORM OPTIONS

St. Gregory the Great Catholic School offers a variety of learning experiences tailored to meet the needs of our community. Parents have the option to register their child in one of the following learning platform categories:

**1** Full-Time  
**Traditional  
Learner**  
Face to Face

**2** Full-Time  
**Distance  
Learner**  
Online

**3** Full-Time  
**Distance  
Learner**  
Self-Paced

### 1. FULL-TIME TRADITIONAL LEARNER

- This refers to the “traditional” in-school experience.
- Registrants should expect the same quality learning experience that has been provided each year.

### 2. FULL-TIME DISTANCE LEARNER

- A full-time distance learner online is a student who works from home full-time but is required to login and participate in class via Zoom (or another video conferencing platform) for all core content classes. Non-core class work will be sent weekly.
- This option is offered to students in 4th through 8th grade only.
- For students in 1st through 3rd grade, a full time distance learning teacher will be hired to send work, provide instruction using the lesson plans from the full-time traditional teachers, and maintain a check in/relationship with each student and their family.
- No “non-traditional” options will be provided to early childhood students because of the emphasis on skills building which cannot be easily replicated online.

### 3. FULL-TIME DISTANCE LEARNER

- A full-time distance learner self-paced is one who works from home but due to extenuating circumstances is unable to login regularly during the day to meet (virtually) with their class. These students would receive the curriculum and some direct instruction but be self-paced at home working with their parents/guardians. The full-time distance learning teacher would be responsible for working with these students and their families.
- This would be offered to students in 1st through 8th grade.

COVID health and safety plans will be implemented in strict compliance with all CDC and health official guidelines. Plans will not be communicated until August because so much is changing each week. We can share that StG will enforce social distancing, encourage (and possibly require) masks, integrate safety zones at desks/in classrooms and common areas, have a major emphasis on health and sanitizing expectations at the start of the year and throughout the year, and more.
