## School Safety Drop Off Procedures

### A couple of Safety reminders:

- ◆ To walk your child to class, you must park in the big church parking lot, where Fr. Rudy works the crossing guard station. You may also park in the ball field parking lot, but you must escort your child to their classroom door.
- ◆ **Parking in the Teacher Parking lot & Rectory parking lot, along side streets in the neighborhood is NOT ALLOWED!!!** These parking spots are for parishioners.
- ◆ **The school office closes at 4:30.** To access after school care in the cafeteria, enter the front cafeteria doors facing Beryl.

### Enforced Beginning 2nd Quarter, (October 22):

- ◆ To minimize classroom instruction interruptions, the school office will NOT buzz classrooms to notify students of dropped off lunches or forgotten homework. (Parent/Student Handbook pg. 63)
- ◆ If you are bringing your child's lunch after their drop off, be sure that they know to check the "Lunch Drop Off Table" in the cafeteria.
- ◆ If you are bringing a child's forgotten homework or project, it will be kept in the front office, and the student may pick it up during their lunch time or after school, the classroom instruction will not be interrupted to remind the student.

### New Beginning 2nd Quarter, (October 22):

- ◆ To help better supervise and protect our students, Early Morning Care will have only one entrance. **Students dropped off before 7:40am must be dropped off at the front cafeteria doors** (on Beryl facing the big Church parking lot).
- ◆ Students arriving before 7:45 must be in Early Morning Care for their safety.
- ◆ The gates for 1st-8th grade drive through will not open until 7:45am.
- ◆ Before 7:40 students will not be allowed to walk through the front office to get to the cafeteria.
- ◆ **If your family is blessed to have Grandparents or other relatives doing the picking up and dropping off for your family, please be sure to notify them of the above reminders.**
