





UIW will be here to provide a complete and comprehensive vision exam for our StG students in PK4, K, 1,3,5 and 7th grade. Despite our current pandemic, vision screening remains a required Texas screening for all schools. We are very blessed to have UIW provide this service to our students.

If you are a parent of Distant Learner, please plan ahead to bring your child to StG on Tuesday, September 22nd or Thursday, September 24th from 9am to 11am.

Screenings will take place in the cafeteria. We ask all parents of Distant Learners to use the church parking lot on Beryl Street. Students will enter via the side door of the cafeteria. However, please be aware that only students will be allowed to enter. We will monitor and maintain COVID practices for the health and safety of all persons.

3rd, 5th and 7th graders will be screened on Tuesday, 22nd PK4, Kinder, and 1st graders will be screened on Thursday, 24th


If your child has completed a comprehensive vision exam from your primary optometrist you may submit the required documentation to Nurse Cruz at naomi.cruz@stgregorys.net.
