Suicide is not a pleasant topic to talk about. It is often stigmatized and often seen as a taboo. September is Suicide Prevention Awareness month, a time to raise awareness on an issue that can effect anyone regardless of age, gender or background. We are all at risk of experiencing mental health issues. It's important that we become aware of the warnings signs and risk factors so we can seek help for ourselves and those we love and care about especially those who might already be experiencing a mental health condition like depression or anxiety. Here are a few signs and factors.

Warning Signs:

Feelings of isolation
Drastic change in mood and behavior
Change in school performance
Withdraw from activities previously enjoyed
Change in sleep pattern
Negative feelings of self
Feeling like a burden to others
Making suicide threats
Giving away things

Risk Factors:

Family history of suicide A serious medical condition Substance or Alcohol abuse Access to firearms A recent loss or tragedy

Parents and Guardians,

In an effort to keep you informed on recent changes to the COVID Protocols, below are highlights of the modifications, dated September 9, 2021.

* Close contact definition is a.) being directly exposed to infectious secretions b.) being within 6 feet of an individual with a test-confirmed case of COVID-19 for a cumulative total of 15 minutes or more over a 24-hour period. Additional factors like mask protocols, ventilation, presence of dividers and case symptomology may affect this determination.

With this in mind, individuals who wear masks properly and consistently may not need to be quarantined but should be monitored for symptoms.

- * Close Contact Quarantine changed from 14-day to 10-day period.
- * As an alternative, the quarantine period can end after Day 7 with a lab-confirmed negative COVID-19 test taken on Day 7 and if no symptoms were reported during the monitoring period.
- * Fully vaccinated individuals exposed to someone with suspected or confirmed COVID-19 do not have to quarantine if they remain asymptomatic. Individuals will be required to produce proof of vaccinations.
- * Individuals who were previously diagnosed with COVID-19 within the last three months do not have to quarantine as long as they remain asymptomatic. These individuals are expected to show evidence of a confirmed case of COVID-19 within the last three months.

Exciting news from Box Tops – Box Tops is continuing its digital program as it has phased out paper box tops!! All you need to do is scan your paper receipt to the Box Tops app or forward your digital receipt to receipts@boxtops4education.com

The free Box Top app can be found using either the App Store or Google Play. Once the app has been downloaded from either the App Store or Google Play, be sure to scan your receipt using the app. The receipt is only good for scanning for up to 14 days after the purchase. For your child to receive credit for the online submissions, please send a screen shot of your account with the number of box tops that you added to me at maria.zertuche@stgregorys.net. I will then place the total in the student spreadsheet, keeping a running tally for the year.

For the 2021-2022 school year, each student will need to submit 10 box tops each month for a free dress day, while each sibling needs to turn in 5 for a free dress day. This year, the student who turns in the most box tops will earn a \$25 giftcard to Target. The class with the highest percentage of turned in box tops will earn a pizza party in May.
