Hunter green/Black St. Gregory School jacket


Grey St. Gregory School sweatshirt

Welcome back and Happy New Year!

The Archdiocese of San Antonio put out a new COVID protocol and will go into effect today. The isolation period has been changed from a 10-day period to a 5-day for a positive test result.

The protocol reads:

Everyone who tests positive, regardless of vaccination status shall:

- Stay home for 5 days. (from the date of the confirmed test)
- If the individual has no symptoms or the symptoms are resolving after 5 days, he/she can return to work/school.
- The individual should continue to wear a mask around others for 5 additional days.

If the individual has a fever or symptoms have not improved, he/she should continue to stay home until the fever resolves and symptoms improve. The individual should be fever free for at least 24 hours.

As a reminder, any FULLY VACCINATED individual OR person who has tested positive for COVID in the last 3-months is not required to quarantine. Instead they may continue to attend school/work and must wear a mask around others for 10 days, including after school and extracurricular activities. However, If at any point the individual develops symptoms, he/she should then stay home for five days or obtain a negative lab-based COVID test.

As COVID cases continue to rise in our community, we ask that if a person in your household develops COVID symptoms or is awaiting COVID test results, that you please keep your child home until you receive the PCR results. By doing this, we hope to minimize the spread on campus.

Communication is key, if your child is absent, please call the school to notify us of their absence. Early detection and identification can prevent further spread so we need your help.

If a student on campus tests positive, I will be in contact with you IF your child was considered at risk or a close contact. If you do not hear from me, then no risk was identified. Vaccinations do make a difference and certainly help to lower the risk of everyone on our campus. If your child has already received the COVID vaccinations please remember to send me a copy of the dates of vaccines for their school.



Exciting news from Box Tops – Box Tops is continuing its digital program as it has phased out paper box tops!! All you need to do is scan your paper receipt to the Box Tops app or forward your digital receipt to receipts@boxtops4education.com

The free Box Top app can be found using either the App Store or Google Play. Once the app has been downloaded from either the App Store or Google Play, be sure to scan your receipt using the app. The receipt is only good for scanning for up to 14 days after the purchase. For your child to receive credit for the online submissions, please send a screen shot of your account with the number of box tops that you added to me at maria.zertuche@stgregorys.net. I will then place the total in the student spreadsheet, keeping a running tally for the year.

For the 2021-2022 school year, each student will need to submit 10 box tops each month for a free dress day, while each sibling needs to turn in 5 for a free dress day. This year, the student who turns in the most box tops will earn a \$25 giftcard to Target. The class with the highest percentage of turned in box tops will earn a pizza party in May. #### ST. GREGORY THE GREAT WOMEN'S ACT


