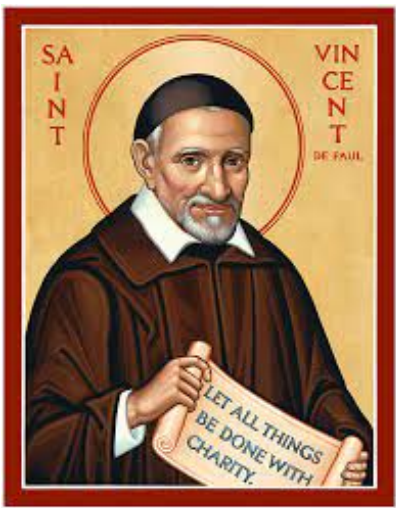

September is Suicide Awareness month. A time to remember those affected by suicide, raise awareness on an issue that can effect anyone regardless of age, gender or background, and focus efforts on directing treatment and services to those who needed it the most.

ASK

Research shows people who are having thoughts of suicide feel relief when someone asks after them in a caring way. Findings suggest talking about suicide may reduce rather than increase suicidal ideation.

BE THERE

Individuals are more likely to feel less depressed, less suicidal, less overwhelmed and more hopeful after speaking with someone who listens without judgement.

KEEP THEM SAFE

Studies indicate that when lethal means are made less available or less deadly suicide rates by that method decline and frequently suicide rates overall decline.

HELP THEM STAY CONNECTED

Studies show that creating a network of resources and individuals support and safety can help someone at risk, take positive actions and reduce feelings of hopelessness.

FOLLOW UP

Studies show that brief, low cost intervention and ongoing contact may be an important part of suicide prevention especially for individuals after they have been discharged from hospitals or care services.

988 Crisis Life line.

988 is the new code that will route callers to the National Suicide Prevention Lifeline. It is an easy number to remember and is now available all across the U.S. Free confidential support 24/7 for anyone in emotional distress or suicide crisis.
